## **KENEDY COUNTY NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON 2026 BUDGET AND 2025 TAX RATE**

**A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED BUDGET AND TAX RATE** will be held on September 8, 2025 at 9 A.M. at the Kenedy County Courthouse District Courtroom, 101 Mallory, Sarita, Texas 78385.

A budget for the year 2026 has been proposed in the amount of \$8,199,914.25.

This includes a 2% salary increase for elected officials.

A tax rate of \$0.800000 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Kenedy County.

PROPOSED TAX RATE:	\$0.800000 PER \$100
NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE:	<u>\$0.856733</u> PER \$100
VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE:	<u>\$0.886742</u> PER \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2025 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Kenedy County from the same properties in both the 2024 tax year and the 2025 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that Kenedy County may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. This means that Kenedy county is not proposing to increase the tax rate for the 2025 tax year.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Kenedy County is not required to hold an election to seek voter approval of the rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the Kenedy County Court of Kenedy County at their offices or by attending the public hearing mentioned above.

The 86<sup>th</sup> Legislature modified the manner in which the voter-approval tax rate is calculated to limit the Rate of growth of property taxes in the state.

The following table compares the taxes imposed on the average residence homestead by Kenedy County last year to the taxes proposed to be imposed on the average residence homestead by Kenedy County this year.

Total tax levy on all properties	\$5,601,405.44	\$5,726,992.66	204,526, or 3.65% increase
